


Keats Pen Kit Fitting / Assembly Guide

Please read this guide fully before beginning any preparation or assembly of the kit

The Keats is a premium pen kit. It features a Parker style refill whilst retaining a slim profile for comfort when writing.




Drill required: 8.0mm

Bushings required: Keat BSH

Blank size: Front 59mm, rear 49mm + extra to allow for trimming

- 1] Roughen the brass tubes and glue into your wood / acrylic blank with your preferred glue
- 2] Once the blanks are dry, trim the 4 ends to ensure they are level
- 3] Insert the bushings onto the blanks, the front bushing is the smaller 9.4mm, then the single centre bushing(9.9mm) and then the rear bushing (9.9mm) (see diagram below)
- 4] turn and finish your blanks as required

For assembly:



- 5] Take the finished front tube and push-fit the nib section into the 9.4mm end of the blank
- 6] Push fit the centre band into the other end of the front tube making sure the threaded section is towards the rear / heel of the pen
- 7] Insert the refill& spring, place the mechanism over the end of the refill and screw onto the centre band. Check the operation of the mechanism & writing tip.
- 8] Take the rear tube and push fit the heel cap / pocket clip assembly onto one end of the finished blank
- 9] Push fit (by hand) the rear section over the steel end of the mechanism
- 10] To change the refill unscrew the front and rear sections and remove / replace the refill and spring

Your Keats pen kit is now finished and ready for use, we hope you have enjoyed making it.
